

Frederick Magazine 2009 Cover Contest

CALL FOR ARTISTS

Frederick Magazine is working in partnership with the Frederick Arts Council to feature the work of an artist for the cover of its September 2009 issue. The issue's theme is "Celebrate Frederick," and the winning artwork must reflect this theme.

The Frederick Arts Council's mission is to serve as the primary catalyst and advocate for arts opportunities in the county. The Frederick Arts Council fosters the growth of the arts, artists and arts organizations through grant and scholarship programs, workshops and arts education forums, and advocacy.

Artist Benefits

The selected artwork will serve as the cover image for the September 2009 issue of *Frederick Magazine*. The artist will also receive a small biographical write-up in the issue.

Artwork Usage

In addition to use of the image for the cover, the artist will grant the rights to *Frederick Magazine* to sell prints and other reproductions of the artwork. The artist will receive 40 percent of all sales. *Frederick Magazine* will bear production costs and receive 40 percent of all sales. The remaining 20 percent will benefit the Frederick Arts Council. Commissions will be paid on revenue generated after production costs are recovered. *Frederick Magazine* reserves the right to crop selected artwork for magazine and print publication.

The selected artist must enter into an agreement with *Frederick Magazine* that will, in part, transfer and assign all rights, title to and interests in the selected artwork to *Frederick Magazine*. *Frederick Magazine*, in turn, will grant the artist a nontransferable right and license to reproduce, distribute, publicly display and create derivative works based on the artist's design or to use images of the design as a sample of their work or philanthropic commitment or for other similar, noncommercial purposes.

Artist Consideration

Artwork must depict Frederick County. Preference is given to artists living or working in Frederick County. However, all artists will be considered. Priority will also be given to artists who are affiliate members of the Frederick Arts Council. Photography and computer-generated art will not be considered.

Submission Details

Artists must submit a digital image (300 dpi jpeg or pdf version) of the artwork being considered. No more than three submissions will be accepted from any one artist. The selection committee may request to see any actual piece of artwork or may base their decision on the electronic version.

The deadline for electronic submission is **Friday, July 24**. The selected artist will be notified by Friday, July 31 and will be required to sign a contract. Interested artists must complete the attached form for each piece submitted and send it along with their electronic images.

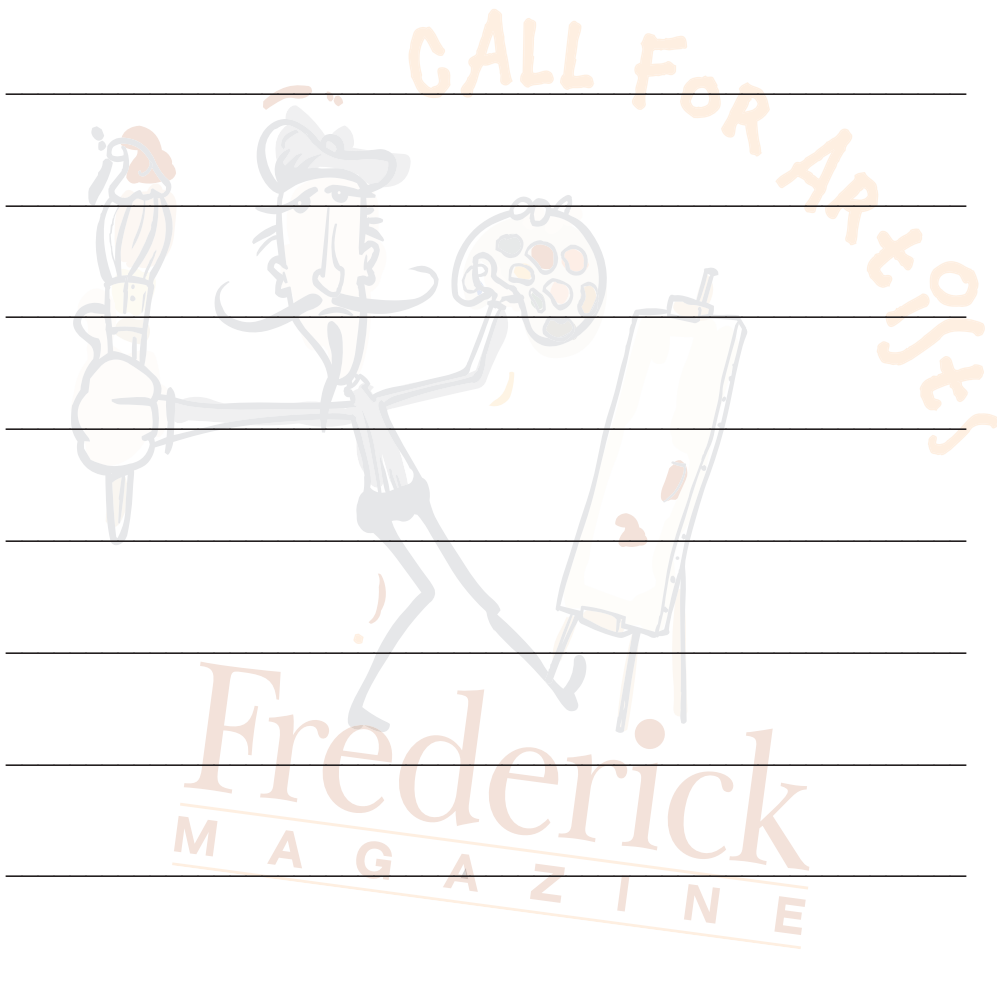
